**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF TULPEHOCKEN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
TO APPOINT DELEGATES TO THE EARNED INCOME TAX
COLLECTION COMMITTEE FOR BERKS COUNTY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Local Tax Enabling Act, Section § 505(b), as amended by Act 32 of 2008, the governing bodies of school districts, townships, boroughs, and cities shall to appoint one voting delegate and one or more alternate delegates to the Tax Collection Committee (TCC) as representatives; and

WHEREAS, the Tulpehocken Township Board of Supervisors desires to appoint Dale Swope as primary voting delegate and John Kintzer as alternate voting delegate; and

WHEREAS, the delegates have consented to their appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to Local Tax Enabling Act, Section § 505(b), as amended by Act 32 of 2008, the following individuals are appointed as TCC delegates for the Township of Tulpehocken:

1. Primary voting delegate: Dale Swope
2. Alternate voting delegate: John Kintzer
3. If the primary voting delegate cannot be present for a TCC meeting, the alternate voting delegate shall be the representative at the TCC meeting.

FURTHER RESOLVED, this appointment shall be effective immediately.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that such appointee shall serve at the pleasure of the Tulpehocken Township Board of Supervisors in such appointive office.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that if any provision, sentence, clause, section, or part of this Resolution shall for any reason be found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such determination shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Resolution, and it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Tulpehocken Township that this Resolution would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid provision, sentence, clause, section or part not been included herein.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that all Resolutions or parts of Resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby superseded.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Township Secretary shall deliver a certified copy of these Resolutions to the appointees.
