

RESOLUTION NO. 1998-1

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act, as amended, has placed the responsibility of enforcing said Act throughout Tulpehocken Township upon the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township has retained the services of a certified Sewage Enforcement Officer; and

WHEREAS, the Township desires to adopt a schedule of permit fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it Resolved that the Board of Supervisors of Tulpehocken Township hereby adopts the following fee schedule for Sewage Enforcement Officer's services:

Fees for sewage enforcement activities to be paid by applicants:

Repair Permit not requiring testing (e.g., failed septic tank, crushed pipe) Includes permit and inspection.	\$ 75.00
Repair permits requiring soils testing and perc tests (includes everything associated with permit: testing, design review, inspections, etc.)	\$390.00
Additional Probes (beyond initial 2) (Repair)	\$ 25.00
Additional Perc Test (Repair)	\$150.00
Inground Permit (Includes Design Review, Issuing Permit and 3 Installation Inspections)	\$230.00
Sandmound Permit (Includes Design Review, Issuing Permit and 4 Installation Inspections)	\$280.00
Design Review	\$ 55.00
Issue/Transfer Permits	\$ 35.00
Inspections Additional	\$ 45.00
Other SEO Work (Hourly Rate)	\$ 38.00
Other SEO Work (Repair)	\$ 19.00
Township Administrative Cost	\$ 25.00

Fees for services where reimbursement is not available (subdivision testing).

Initial 2 Probes	\$ 90.00
Additional Probes	\$ 45.00
Percolation Tests (6-hole Perc Test)	\$285.00
Primary and Alternate 12-hole Perc Test	\$465.00

Hourly rate will be billed for Planning Module review, verification of prior testing, misc. site visits at property owner's request, and other items not covered by basic fee schedule.

Compensation of the Sewage Enforcement Officer:

The appointed Sewage Enforcement Officer shall be compensated at a rate of \$38.00 per hour plus out of pocket expenses, including mileage at the prevailing IRS rate, and a digging and presoak fee of \$45.00 for each perc test performed.

It is further resolved that the appointed Sewage Enforcement Officer is hereby authorized to collect the above mentioned fees on behalf of the Township.
