

RESOLUTION NO. 2001-3

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TULPEHOCKEN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO DESIGNATE THE MONTHS OF MARCH AND OCTOBER AS THE ANNUAL TIME PERIODS FOR SUBMISSION OF PETITIONS TO MAKE ADDITIONS TO THE TULPEHOCKEN TOWNSHIP AGRICULTURAL AREA SECURITY DISTRICT.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Tulpehocken, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same as follows:

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Tulpehocken Township has declared its policy to preserve and protect and to encourage the development and improvements of the agricultural lands within the Township of Tulpehocken through the creation and expansion of the Agricultural Area Security District; and

WHEREAS, the existing Security District has been amended on several occasions; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Tulpehocken Township desire to formalize two monthly periods per year in which to receive petitions to make additions to said Agricultural Area Security District; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board of Supervisors to designate the months of March and October as the periods of time in which such petitions will be accepted for consideration.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Tulpehocken, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the months of March and October are hereby designated as the annual periods of time in which the Board of Supervisors shall accept for consideration petitions requesting the addition of land to the existing Tulpehocken Township Agricultural Area Security District. Any and all petitions submitted to or received by the Township other than within the months of March and October shall be returned to the applicant and shall not be reconsidered by the Board of Supervisors unless such petitions are re-submitted at the next designated month for consideration.

SECTION 2. All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed insofar, but only insofar, as the same are inconsistent herewith.
