Tulpehocken Township Planning Commission Meeting August 5, 2021

Active Plans:

<u>Capitol City Remodelers, LLC</u>: Time expires August 25, 2021. Burget & Associates, Inc., the applicant's engineer, presented a time extension letter to the Township for a continuance until the November 2021 Board of Supervisors meeting, which would be November 10, 2021. John Zimmerman made a motion to recommend to the Board of Supervisors to grant the time extension request for Capitol City Remodelers, LLC as a time extension to November 10, 2021. Seconded by Robert Sattazahn and approved unanimously.

<u>Mt. Meadows Phase 2-Final Plan:</u> Time expires November 2, 2021 for this plan. The Township Engineer spoke with the Developer, Mr. Hurst. Mr. Hurst is converting the existing temporary basin in Phase I over to the permanent basin. The Phase II basin was also discussed and Mr. Hurst agreed to soften the side slopes of the basin from 2:1 to 3:1 in the wet areas during construction.

There is an empty lot along Clover Drive that has high weeds.

<u>Sketch Plan for Record Shirk Farm Annexation</u>: Time expires November 10, 2021 for this plan. No discussion.

New Plans: None.

Walk-In Discussions: Eric & Sharon Hever were present. They have purchased lot# 4 in the Shoestring Industries Subdivision. The Planning Commission Secretary provided them with the Township Engineer's contact information to discuss stormwater for their lot. They were also given zoning and building application forms.
