New Business

A specially advertised meeting was held by the Tulpehocken Township Board of Supervisors on the above stated date starting at 5pm at the Tulpehocken Township Building. This meeting was for the purpose of opening sealed bids for the 2022 Road Paving Project for Witman Road and any other business that the Board may need to discuss. Chairman Gary Deck and Supervisor/Roadmaster Lester Feick were in attendance. The Chairman opened the meeting with the Pledge to Flag.

With the total amount of the project being revealed, Roadmaster Lester Feick stated that there is room in the budget to add an additional 2/10" of depth to the paving project. No further action was taken at this time.
