AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TULPEHOCKEN, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2015-2 TO AMEND, RE-ADOPT AND SET FORTH A SCHEDULE OF ATTORNEYS' FEES TO BE COLLECTED IN CONNECTION WITH THE COLLECTION OF DELINQUENT SEWER ACCOUNTS PURSUANT TO ACT NO. 1 OF 1996

Section 1 amends Ordinance No. 2015-2 to amend the fees to be charged by the Township Solicitor in connection with the collection of delinquent sewer accounts. Section 2 provides that all costs and expenses incurred by the Township Solicitor in connection with the collection of delinquent accounts shall also be included in liens against the properties and shall be the responsibility of delinquent account holders in other collection actions. Section 3 provides that the provisions of this Ordinance are severable. Section 4 is the repealer provision. Section 5 provides for the effective date.
