

**Tulpehocken Township Board of Supervisors  
Meeting of November 12, 2025  
Preliminary Budget Meeting and Other Business**

The Tulpehocken Township Board of Supervisors met on November 12, 2025 at 5:30 P.M., in the Township meeting room. In attendance and voting were Supervisors: Chairman Gary Deck, Vice Chairman Lester Feick and Harold Zimmerman. Also present were Bryan Dronick, Police Chief; Kathy Judy, Township Secretary/Treasurer and Lisa Care, Sewer Services Secretary.

There were no members of the audience.

**CALL TO ORDER:** Chairman Deck called the meeting to order at 5:30 P.M.  
The meeting continued with the pledge to the American Flag.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**Review 2026 Preliminary Budgets:**

**Township Funds** – The line-item breakdown for each account was reviewed and discussed by the Board. Changes were made to the General Fund projected revenues and expenses; and to the Liquid Fuels Fund expenses for Snow/Ice Removal. According to the proposed budget reviewed tonight, with the changes made by the Board, the total expected revenue for all accounts (General, Street Light, Liquid Fuels, Building Maintenance, Recreation, P.T.O. and ARP Funds) in 2026, not including the sewer account, amounted to \$2,206, 020. The total expenses for these same accounts, not including the sewer funds, amounted to \$1,994,512.

**Sewer Funds** – The line item breakdown for each account was reviewed and discussed by the Board. No changes were made. According to the proposed budget reviewed tonight the total expected revenues for 2026 is \$507,797. Expected expenses amount to \$504,850., including loan payments.

*Vice Chairman Feick made a motion to advertise that the 2026 Proposed Budgets are available for public inspection and will come before the Board for adoption at the December 10, 2025 meeting at 7:00 PM - - seconded by Supervisor Zimmerman and passed unanimously (3-0)*

**OTHER BUSINESS:**

Online payment of sewer service fees – the Board reviewed an Agreement and discussed Municipay with the Sewer Service Secretary. *Vice Chairman Feick made a motion to authorize the Chairman to sign the agreement with Autoagent for Municipay services - - seconded by Supervisor Zimmerman and passed unanimously (3-0).* This will be discussed also at the Board of Supervisors meeting scheduled for 7:00 PM, following the close of this Budget meeting.

**ADJOURNMENT OF MEETING:** *Vice Chairman Feick made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:52 P.M. - - seconded by Supervisor Zimmerman and passed unanimously (3-0).*
